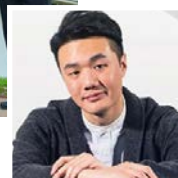
THE BLUE ROSE TRIO JANUARY 13 • SATURDAY • 3 PM

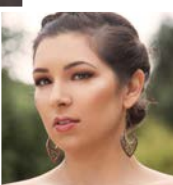
FILIPPO LUGNAN MAY 11 • SATURDAY • 3 PM
